## Bible reading – 2 Timothy 3:1-17

<sup>1</sup> But know this: Hard times will come in the last days. <sup>2</sup> For people will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, proud, demeaning, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, <sup>3</sup> unloving, irreconcilable, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, without love for what is good, <sup>4</sup> traitors, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, <sup>5</sup> holding to the form of godliness but denying its power. Avoid these people.

<sup>6</sup> For among them are those who worm their way into households and deceive gullible women overwhelmed by sins and led astray by a variety of passions, <sup>7</sup> always learning and never able to come to a knowledge of the truth. <sup>8</sup> Just as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so these also resist the truth. They are men who are corrupt in mind and worthless in regard to the faith. <sup>9</sup> But they will not make further progress, for their foolishness will be clear to all, as was the foolishness of Jannes and Jambres.

<sup>10</sup> But you have followed my teaching, conduct, purpose, faith, patience, love, and endurance, <sup>11</sup> along with the persecutions and sufferings that came to me in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra. What persecutions I endured – and yet the Lord rescued me from them all. <sup>12</sup> In fact, all who want to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. <sup>13</sup> Evil people and impostors will become worse, deceiving and being deceived. <sup>14</sup> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed. You know those who taught you, <sup>15</sup> and you know that from infancy you have known the sacred Scriptures, which are able to give you wisdom for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>16</sup> All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.
